

Many Years

For hierarchs, novices, and laymen

Deacon: A prosperous and peaceful life, health and salvation, and good success in all things, grant, O Lord, unto Thy servant(s), **N.**, and preserve him (her) (them) for many years.

Choir: God, grant you many years. **Twice.**
Then, Save him (her) (them), O Christ God.

Monastic Many Years

Deacon: O Christ God, save our brother (sister), **N.**, and establish and preserve this (her) holy monastery in peace unto the ages of ages.

Choir: Save him (her), O Christ God. **Thrice.**

After a meal, if a hierarch is present, then:

Choir: Eis polla eti, Despota.

Memory Eternal

Deacon: In a blessed falling asleep, grant, O Lord, eternal rest unto Thy departed servant(s), **N.**, and make his (her) (their) memory to be eternal.

Choir: Memory eternal. **Thrice.**

Priest: May God bless and give him (her) (them) rest, and have mercy on us, for He is good and the Lover of mankind.

Choir: Amen.

Notes

After Liturgy, *Many Years* is intoned first, then *Memory Eternal*.

After a meal, *Eternal Memory* is intoned first, then *Many Years*.
